8th grade needs to complete two assignments.

Choose 2 books to read from the 8th grade summer reading list, and then complete the following:

9. Tell Me Three Things by Julie Bixbaum

First book:

For the first activity, students must create a power point presentation with at least 15 slides describing the book. Pretend you are the teacher, and you are trying to describe the book to your students. What would you include? Use graphics with captions. You don't want to bore your "students," so make your PowerPoint presentation interesting!

Second book:
